(2) Cst. Scriven conducted a phone interview with Terry Pugh from The Gazette regarding the spring road bans for public information.

(3) RM Public Works Foreman has advised major projects scheduled for the upcoming months which will begin in May. Members will monitor these locations for the safety, ensuring vehicles are adhering to the road work signage.

(4) Commission Member Pshebylo questioned if members are trained with detecting intoxication by cannabis. Chief Chomyn responded that 4 members have just completed a 4 day course in Standard Field Sobriety Test (SFST) through Saskatoon Police Service. Eventually all members receive this training. Members are also trained in the use of equipment - SoToxa and Draeger drug test.
