

Rivers Edge Estates Annual General Meeting  
Tuesday April 23, 2019, 7pm Seymour Residence

1. Presidents Report: Main project was to surface Range Road 3045 with SB90 part way to the corner of Township Road 374. Diane S attended the all Hamlets meeting of Corman Park. She had emailed a report to all residents after the meeting.
2. Review of the 2018 Financial Report: Reviewed the statement for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2018. Sonja B made a motion to accept the report seconded by Elsie R.
3. Review of the 2018 minutes: Cindy M moved to accept the minutes seconded by Connie S.
4. Election of new officers: Sonja B volunteered to stay on in this position for another term of 3 years. All in favour.
5. Roads: At the all Hamlets meeting the RM stated they would try a product called EMC squared to surface Township Road 374 up to Range Road 3050. The hamlet residents stated they would like to write letters to some of the elected officials about controlling the dust on 374. A letter will be drafted and sent to all the residents who can sign it and send to their elected officials. A letter from the Hamlet will also be sent.

Cindy M made a motion that the Hamlet continue SB90 road surface to the intersection of 374 and 3050. Seconded by Connie S. Motion carried.

Dave S will organize this project. Dave thought this could be done at the end of May or first part of June as the company (Sands Dust Control) will be in the area around that time.

Dianne S made a motion that garbage and recycle bins be moved from the edge of the road and bins moved to the river side of the road so Loraas truck only needs to make one pass, hopefully preventing wear on the edge of the road surface. All in favour

6. Rural Crime Watch: WhatsApp was to be available to share information with the RCMP. This did not work as not secure for RCMP to use WhatsApp. Residents are to call East side RCMP 306 975 5173 or Corman Park Police 306 242 8808 to report suspicious activity. Must share location with them or pin drop. If intruder on your property dial 911.

Our Hamlet will have two WhatsApp groups. One will be for Rivers Edge Crime Watch and the Rivers Edge Group Chat will be for social announcements, gatherings etc

7. Dog Bylaw: Discussion to respect others by doing our best to keep dogs in our own yard. When walking your dogs on the inner circle they are to be on a leash and by your side. On the outer circle they don't have to be.
8. New Business: If you want a Rural Crime Watch sign let Diane know and she will order one . Hamlet will pay for the sign.

Reminder to ensure you have adequate fire-fighting insurance as well as property loss insurance . Property owners are responsible to pay the cost of fire-fighting on their property. It was suggested to have coverage for at least \$20,000.

The annual meeting for Highway 41 water utility in Aberdeen is April 24. Residents to attend if they wish.

Lorraine S moved the meeting to be adjourned seconded by Howie C.

Addendum: Subsequent to the meeting new Information was received. Diane spoke to the RM and they have plans to extend the surfacing of EMCsquared 1/2 mile south on 3050 towards the Wild Life Federation. In view of the new information, Diane talked to Eric who was going to draft the letter to elected officials for the residents, they now feel this action will not be necessary.
