(1) Discussion of the increase of driving offences in the RM and the increase of patrols on RM roadways.

(2) Discussion on the 1 year Check Stop pilot program with SGI. Corman Park Police is one of the top 3 agencies, behind Saskatoon Police Service and Regina Police Service, for impaired driving enforcement. The force participated in 13 check stops in 2021 and will be participating in 15 for 2022. These initiatives are attended by off duty members and is paid for by SGI. No members are removed from duty to attend.

(3) Resulting from the effective work with impaired driving enforcement, the force has received an additional 2 SoToxa machines from SGI.

(4) Chief Chomyn discussed a call from Chief Troy Cooper with Saskatoon Police Service wanting to commend one of the members on his professionalism during a traffic stop that he had witnessed.
