6. Stop Signs – Township Road 372 & Range Road 3043

At the May 22, 2018 meeting, Council directed Administration to review the existing stop signs at the following intersections:

- Blackley and Fleury Roads (Rge Rd 3044 & Twp Rd 372)
- Llewellyn and Fleury Roads (Rge Rd 3043 & Twp Rd 372)

Currently Blackley Rd is located within City of Saskatoon limits and access west of this intersection was recently closed by the City of Saskatoon.

The intersection of Llewellyn Rd (Rge Rd 3043) and Fleury Rd (Twp Rd 372) is presently controlled by a four 4-way stop intersection. Administration was asked to investigate if this can be made into a 2-way stop.

Update:

Administration has reviewed the area and recommends that the 4-way Stop remain since the area is likely to grow with a school and church being built adjacent to the Rge Rd 3043 and Twp Rd 372 intersection.

➤ **Recommendation:**

Rooke: That the 4-way Stop remain at the intersection of Llewellyn Road and Fleury Road since the area is likely to grow with a school and church being built adjacent to the Rge Rd 3043 and Twp Rd 372 intersection.
