OVERWEIGHT PERMIT / AGREEMENT:

\$30 + GST per truck or **\$41.13 / km + GST (Winter)** **\$82.26 / km +GST (Summer)**

YEARLY PERMIT / AGREEMENT

Cost of maintaining and restoring municipal roads:

Summer - **\$0.0215 +GST per tonne** or **\$0.0383 +GST / m³** of load per kilometer

Winter - **\$0.01075 +GST per tonne** or **\$0.01915+GST / m³** of load per kilometer

or a minimum of **\$41.13 / km +GST (Winter)** or **\$82.26 / km +GST (Summer)**

Compensation for any shortening of the lifetime of the municipal roads

Summer - **\$0.0184+GST / tonne** or **\$0.0327 +GST/m³** of load per kilometer

Winter - **\$0.0092+GST / tonne** or **\$0.01635 +GST/m³** of load per kilometer

Extraction Fee Associated with Discretionary Use of Property for Mineral Resource Extraction Activities

\$0.122+GST per cubic yard or **\$0.086+GST per tonne** or **\$0.160+GST per cubic meter**

Restrictions/Conditions included in the Permit

- This permit **does not authorize the user to exceed** Primary Provincial Weight Standards.
- This permit shall be carried at all times and shall be produced upon request by a peace officer. The permit is null and void if not carried.
- This permit is also valid during Spring Road Restrictions.
- Any violation of this permit will be deemed sufficient reason to suspend or cancel this permit.
- Abide by a Maximum Speed Limit of 60 km an hour on all Municipal roads, or by any Speed Limit lower than previously specified.

By executing this agreement/permit the applicant will undertake to observe the terms and conditions set forth in this agreement/permit and to pay to the municipality on demand such sum as may be required to remedy any damage caused to the roads, bridges, culverts, or any of them, specified in this permit through the operation of the said vehicle or vehicles or in any way arising out of the operations covered by this permit. Notwithstanding any other provision of this agreement, in the event the hauler fails to meet any term, condition, or obligation in the agreement, the agreement is or becomes nonexistent.
