Policy Title: Gravelling of Summer Roads

Policy Objective: To provide a consistent procedure for cost sharing with ratepayers for the gravelling of summer roads.

Authority: (Bylaw#, Resolution date/#)
Policy PW-54 adopted May 14, 2012; re-affirmed June 10, 2013

Policy:

- The RM will budget, annually, \$10,000.00 to be apportioned toward the gravelling of summer roads when requested by ratepayers.
- Cost-share between the RM and specific ratepayer will be 50/50 to a maximum of \$1,000.00 per mile or request per ratepayer per year.
- Yearly, an advertisement will be placed in the Clark's Crossing Gazette requesting that ratepayers interested in gravelling a summer road submit a written request listing the location and length of the summer road. The advertisement shall specify a closing date for submissions, which shall be determined by the Director of Public Works.
- Any motor grader time required to prep the location for gravelling will be provided at no charge.
- Inspection will occur prior to undertaking and upon completion by the RM.
- The RM will make available any aggregate from its inventory and will also load and haul aggregate to the location.
- Any materials to be used by the applicant shall be inspected and approved by the RM prior to application.
- The applicant shall acknowledge and agree to these policy terms prior to work commencing.
- The maximum amount the RM will cost-share for the supply and hauling of road gravel is \$25.00/yd³.
- Upon deadline of submissions a list will be compiled.
- The list will be compiled, reviewed and successful applications chosen by the Director of Public Works, in his sole discretion. A key component and consideration in the decision process will be the aim to allocate the work throughout the entire RM, if submissions are received from throughout the RM.
- A detailed report will be created outlining all interested parties and the respective requests and provided to Council for information.
