


**A BYLAW TO APPOINT BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
  - a) "Council" means the Council of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344; and
  - b) "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344
  
2. Council hereby appoints The Corman Park Police Service Members as the Bylaw Enforcement Officers for the Municipality.
  - a) The appointment shall commence January 9, 2012 and shall continue; at the pleasure of Council.
  
3. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Corman Park Police Commission giving 3 months written notice.
  
4. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
  - a) to enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the Council of the Municipality;
  - b) to represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw;
  - c) and other duties as may be assigned or excluded by Council.
  
5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on January 9, 2012.
