



BYLAW NO. 31/20

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw;
 - a) "firearm" means a pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun or any other device or mechanism capable of firing or propelling bullets, pellets, darts, arrows, or any other thing;
 - b) "Country Residential Subdivision" – means any area within the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344 which under the provisions of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344 Zoning Bylaw or the Saskatoon Planning District Zoning Bylaw zoned CR1, CR3, CR4, DCR1, DCR2, DCR3, DCR4 or DCR5
 - c) "Commercial Subdivision" - means any area within the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344 which under the provisions of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344 Zoning Bylaw or the Saskatoon Planning District Zoning Bylaw zoned C, M1, M2, REC, DB, DM1, DM2, DC1, DC2, DREC1 or DRM1.
2. No person shall discharge any firearm within a Country Residential Subdivision or Commercial Subdivision or within five hundred (500) metres of such subdivision.
3. In addition to Section (2), no person shall discharge any firearm within the Municipality except:
 - a) by a person on land which he or she owns, leases or rents, or a member of his/her family or any other person with his or her permission on the said land; or
 - b) by a person, who during open hunting season, holds a license to hunt wildlife as defined under *The Wildlife Act*, issued to him or her under *The Wildlife Act*; or
 - c) where Council has issued a permit to a recognized gun club or similar organization.
4. This bylaw does not apply to any person having authority under a statute of Canada or Saskatchewan to have in his possession a firearm when such firearm is discharged under the authority of his/her duty and within the scope of his/her duty.
5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this Municipality or to the penalties contained in Schedule 1 of this Bylaw.



SCHEDULE 1 to BYLAW NO. 31/20

OFFENCE	PENALTY
Section 2 – Discharge a firearms within a Country Residential Subdivision or within 500 metres of such subdivision	1 st Offence - \$1,000 fine Early Payment Option - \$500 2 nd and Subsequent Offences – \$2,000 fine
Section 3(a) – Discharge a firearm on land not owned/rented/leased without permission	1 st Offence - \$1,000 fine Early Payment Option - \$500 2 nd and Subsequent Offences – \$2,000 fine
Section 3(b) – Discharge a firearm during a hunting season without a hunting licence	1 st Offence - \$1,000 fine Early Payment Option - \$500 2 nd and Subsequent Offences – \$2,000 fine
Section 3(c) – Discharge a firearm without a gun club permit	1 st Offence - \$1,000 fine Early Payment Option - \$500 2 nd and Subsequent Offences – \$2,000 fine
