5. **Beam Road**

Councillor Greenwood brought forward for discussion dust control on Beam Road along the BizHub Industrial Park.

6. **Dust Control – Buck’s Auto**

7. **Chennell’s Road**

Councillor Greenwood brought forward for discussion a complaint from a ratepayer regarding the operation of a school bus on Chennell’s Road and a request for the YIELD signs to be replaced with STOP signs in the area. There is a low volume of traffic and clear sight lines along the road and after discussion with the Chief of Police, the YIELD signs will be left as is.

8. **Rge Rd 3053**

Councillor Froese-Kooijenga brought forward for discussion concerns regarding dust control on Rge Rd 3053 south of Martensville. Administration will investigate the concerns and bring back a report to Council.

9. **Twp Rd 384**

Councillor Vaandrager brought forward for discussion concerns regarding dust control on Twp Rd 384. Administration will investigate the concerns and bring back a report to Council.

10. Road Bans

Councillor Pruiim brought forward for discussion a question regarding the R.M. opting out of Road Bans at this time due to the extreme dryness and lack of frost in the ground.
