

Rivers Edge Estates Annual General Meeting

1. President's Report:

Work was done on the roads as stated in last year's minutes. The all Hamlets meeting with the RM was not held due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

2. Financial Report:

Given by Sonja B.

She explained the Provincial grant and Municipal Tax Allocation.

Dave S. moved to accept the report, seconded by Diane S.

Carried.

3. Minutes of the last Meeting:

No errors or omissions.

Erika M. moved to accept the minutes, seconded by Sonja B.

4. Roads:

Questions were raised if improvements were needed on 3045 from in front of the Tirk residence to the corner – approximately 0.6KM. Suggested that surface needed to be a bit wider than it is now. Cost of gravel to do this was \$6 to \$8,000.

Estimated cost of SB90 was \$22 to \$24,000.

Estimated cost of chip seal was \$21 to \$22,000.

Rick S. made a motion that we apply chip seal the 0.6KM section from in front of the Tirk residence to the corner by Jeff's residence. Seconded by Cindy M. Motion carried.

Eric G. made a motion to spend up to \$32,000 on the road upgrade, seconded by Cindy M. Carried.

5. Loraas Organic Composting:

This would only be done for six months of the year from May to October. Garbage and recycling would be on the same rotation. All bins would be the same size. The cost for the 15 households for the remainder of the year would be \$360.00.

Roman S. made a motion to have green bin organic composting, seconded by Andrea E. Carried.

6. Election.

Secretary position is up for election.

Brigitte S. nominated and she accepted the position.

7. New Business:

A discussion was held about the road off McOrmond Dr. 3050 belonging to the city, which needs improvement. It was noted the RM was planning to pave the section of 3050 to 374. There was also talk of the RM paving a section of 374. Diane S. made a motion and seconded by Cindy M. that Eric G. would contact the city about their section of 3050 as we feel now it is a safety concern. We wonder if the city could work together with the RM to improve this section. Eric G. will draft a letter and send it to everyone to see if they would like to add anything before sending it to the city.

It was suggested to ask anyone who comes out with a heavy load to drive on the middle of the road to preserve the edges. If the road breaks up in front of your property please put some sand and oil on it. Sand pile is close to the approach where the old farmhouse used to be.
