9. Chief's Report

(1) **Sgt Promotion** - Chief Chomyn reported that Cst. Dana Schreiner has been promoted to an Operational Sgt position effective August 6th. Now with 2 Sgt positions, they will begin to work evening hours and will work the exact hours of the members.

Due to this, a constable position has been posted through SACP office to all municipal agencies. Chief is considering a recruit position for college in January if a lateral officer is not found

(2) **Saskatoon International Raceway (SIR)** – Chief Chomyn reported he reached out to management of SIR to discuss members attending race dates simply for community engagement – not for enforcement.

(3) **Highschool Graduation Events** - Chief Chomyn reported members were aware of all events planned at the riverbank and enforcement was positive.

- (4) **Enforcement** – Chief Chomyn reported enforcement has increased 6% from this time last year. Bylaw enforcement is also approximately increased 18% for the same time period.
- (5) **Grant Application** – Chief Chomyn reported that in February of 2023 he submitted an application to the Provincial Safety Committee for a trailer with speed and message board which will be utilized by both the police and Public Works. He received an approval notice for \$22,721 at the beginning of July. The sign has been ordered.
- (6) **E-Ticketing** – Commission Member Booth requested a status update. Chief Chomyn advised training has been completed and expect it to be implemented next week.
