Public Works Committee Minutes

5. Beam Road (Twp Rd 372)

Dust Control Policy TS014 was adopted by Council to help set criteria for Administration to determine when the R.M. would cover the cost of the application of dust control.

Calcium Chloride dust control shall be provided at the cost of the R.M., only under the following circumstances:

- 1) *Adjacent to residences along gravel roadways with an average daily traffic count of equal to or greater than 500, upon review of the traffic count and approval by R.M. Council. Dust control will be applied a maximum of two applications per year, at intervals determined by the Administrator or designate (Director of Public Works)*
- 2) *Adjacent to single severance residences or businesses along gravel roadways leading to a significant multi-parcel development that generates*

traffic. Locations must be approved by Council for inclusion within this policy for annual application.

Administration has received requests for dust control along Beam road (Twp Rd 372) from the Dalmeny access (Grid 684) east to the Bizhub Industrial Park. As per Policy TS014 traffic counters were placed at the intersection of Dividend Drive and Beam Road and the daily traffic count was recorded at 1,087 cars/day.

➤ **Recommendation:**

Greenwood: That the R.M. provide a one-time application of dust control on Twp Rd 372 in front of the Bizhub Industrial Park in spring 2022 and that Administration investigate a more permanent solution to the dust control problem on this section of Beam Road.

6. **Clarence Ave (Rge Rd 3053) Speed Limit Change Request**

Background:

At the September 17, 2018 Council meeting 1st reading was given regarding the posted speed limit along Rge Rd 3053 (Clarence Avenue) as part of a rezoning and Subdivision application for Prairie Lane Estates Ltd.

xvii. That the posted speed limit along Range Road 3053 (Clarence Avenue) be reduced from 80 km/hr to 60 km/hr between Twp. Rd. 360 (Grasswood Road) to Twp. Rd. 354 (Baker Road);

As part of the 2021 Capital Budget Plan, funds were allocated for the Clarence Ave project - Construction of a Surfacing Structure on Rge Rd 3053 (Clarence Avenue) between Grasswood Rd (Twp Rd 360) and 900m south of Baker Rd (Twp Rd 354); for a Total distance of 4.3 km.

The contract is near completion and as a result the R.M. should consider the designated speed limit of the road segment post-construction.

Update:

Currently the speed limit along Clarence Avenue from the south limit of the City of Saskatoon to the intersection of Grasswood Road (Twp Rd 360) is 60 km/h. The speed limit from the intersection of Baker Rd (Twp Rd 354) south, is 80km/h. The request is to reduce the speed limit from 80km/h to 60 km/h from Grasswood Road to south of Baker Road.

➤ **Recommendation:**

Chuhaniuk: That the request for a reduced speed limit from 80 km/h to 60 km/h on Clarence Avenue (Rge Rd 3053) from Grasswood through to 900m south of Baker Rd (Twp Rd 354) be denied.
