Policy Objective : To establish criteria for naming roads and paying for the cost of the signs

Background :

POLICY:

Road Name Policy

- A. Council may at its discretion name any road in the Municipality;
- B. The name given to a road shall reflect:
 1. the name commonly given to a road;
 2. the geographic area; or
 3. recognition of a pioneer.
- C. Once Council agrees in principal to name a road a letter shall be sent to owners of property adjacent to said road advising of such intention and giving any interested party an opportunity to comment;
- D. The proponent of a road naming shall pay for any costs incurred by the Municipality in advertising the proposal and in erecting the sign; If the sign requires replacement, the Municipality will only provide one replacement sign and the proponent will be required to pay for any additional signs required.
- E. Where a road intersects a Provincial Highway the road name sign shall be erected by Sask. Highways and Transportation in accordance with their procedures and policies. Where a road does not intersect a Provincial Highway the Municipality shall erect signs where a said road intersects a major grid road.
