
INTENT

Proposed Bylaw No. 64/20 will rezone from Agricultural District (AG) to Agricultural Residential 1 District (AR1) the lands described below. Proposed Bylaw No. 64/20 will provide for the creation of a separate title for an existing residential yardsite.

AFFECTED LANDS

The affected lands are all that portion of NW 10-39-8-W3 shown shaded on Map 1 (Bylaw 64/20).

PUBLIC INSPECTION

Any person may inspect the proposed Bylaw between 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, up to 5:00 p.m. until December 18, 2020. The proposed Bylaws are also posted for online viewing at www.rm-cormanpark.ca under Public Notice.

PUBLIC HEARING

Council will hold a public hearing on Monday, December 21, 2020 at 11:00 a.m. at the R.M. of Corman Park Office at 111 Pinehouse Drive, Saskatoon, SK to hear any person or group that wants to comment on the proposed Bylaw. Please note sanitizing and distancing measures are in effect, including staggered access into the Council Chambers to ensure protocols are observed. The R.M. Council meeting and public hearing will also be held via remote GoToMeeting, which is open to the public online via computer, tablet or device and over the phone. All written comments received by 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, December 15, 2020 will be forwarded to Council.
