



**BYLAW NO. 13/24
Haying Bylaw**


A BYLAW TO REGULATE HAYING WITHIN MUNICIPAL RIGHT OF WAY

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the Haying Bylaw
2. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - a. "municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344.
 - b. "road" means a "public highway" as defined by The Municipalities Act.
3. Conditions for the salvage of hay from a road in the Municipality.
 - a. The adjacent landowner, or lessee in the case of rented land, has first option to salvage hay along municipal roads. Other persons must receive permission from the adjacent landowner or lessee to salvage the hay on or before July 8 each year.
 - b. After July 8th, any person may cut and salvage hay without the permission of the adjacent landowner or lessee, provided the adjacent landowner or lessee has not begun salvage operations.
 - c. The right-of-way must be left in a neat appearance by the person salvaging the hay.
 - d. Bales of hay must be placed near the property line.
 - e. All bales must be removed from the right-of-way by August 8th.
 - f. The Council reserves the privilege and right for its members, employees and/or agents to enter upon said right-of-way for the maintenance and/or reconstruction of said roadway or for other such purposes as may be deemed necessary, and at no compensation or reimbursement to the party salvaging the hay therefrom.
 - g. The Municipality assumes no liability for laborers, machinery or bales relating to the salvage of hay operations.
 - h. In order to minimize hazards to motorists, any bales not meeting the requirements of items 3. d and 3. e may be removed by the Municipality and any bales so removed shall become the property of the Municipality and may be removed on a first come first serve basis by any interested ratepayer.
 - i. No person shall cut hay on any portion of a road located in this Municipality during the period from one-half (1/2) hour after sunset until one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise.

- j. No person shall cut hay on any portion of a road located in this Municipality to obstruct the travelled portion of the public road.
 - k. Notwithstanding subsection 3. a. the Municipality may conduct mowing operations in certain areas prior to July 8 as required for safety, aesthetic and weed control reasons, without notice to the adjacent landowners and/or lessees.
 - l. No person shall be permitted to salvage hay in areas containing prohibited or noxious weeds with the exception of haying by adjacent landowners or lessees for hay being consumed on property adjacent to the salvage area. Exceptions may be granted by the Weed Inspector.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed by the General Penalty Bylaw 35/20 of the municipality.
5. Bylaw 05/13 the Haying Bylaw, and all amendments thereto, are hereby repealed.
